- ▶ Developing a Pensioners Club in addition to a Seniors Club with the plan of a fixed structure in תשע"ד.
- ▶ Establishing and staffing an active Mischakiya (indoor play area) for young children.
- ▶ Placing of billboards for the holidays at the entrance to the Yishuv.
- ▶ Doubling the number of Sherut Leumi volunteers who assist in the ganim, school and Bnei Akiva.
- ▶ Publishing the Weekly Newsletter with current updates.
- ▶ Renovating the Bnei Akiva snif and installing brick flooring outside.

Accomplishments of the current Vaad (2007-2012)

Security and safety:

- ▶ Installation of smart electronic gate at the entrance to the Yishuv.
- ▶ Installation of cameras at strategic points inside Yishuv.
- ▶ Operation of vehicular patrols day and night in the community in coordination with the IDF.
- ▶ Dramatic reduction in incidents of theft and vandalism. In 2011 there was only 1 reported burglary (43 burglaries the prior year).
- ▶ Improved morning traffic flow by the school as a result of changing HaCarmel Street (school zone) to a oneway street from 7:00-9:00 as well as making HaTavor a permanent oneway street.
- ▶ Securing an agreement with the Municipality of Modi'in Illit to participate in the cost of security.

Community and youth:

- ▶ Employing youth coordinators who have developed a broader range of activities during the summer and school year.
- ▶ Providing a part time "Av Bayit" for the Moadon Noar, and refurbished and refurnished the space.
- ▶ Organizing the Adloyada Purim Parade twice.
- ▶ Organizing the Yom Haatzmaut celebrations and instituting the street fair on HaCarmel.
- ▶ Distributing an annual symbolic Rosh Hashanna gift to Yishuv residents as well as gifts to young men and women going into the army or national service.
- ▶ Developing a staff position whose role is to assist new residents and Olim Chadashim with the absorption process.

Development and construction:

- ▶ Construction and operation of the Mikveh.
- ▶ Construction and operation of the library.
- ▶ Upgrading and repaving the southern ring road.
- ▶ Starting work on a traffic circle at the entrance of the Yishuv in conjunction with the National Roads Company.
- ▶ Planning and obtaining resources for an indoor sports facility whose construction will begin next year.
- ▶ Installing computerized water meters that can be remotely read and warn of leakage.
- ▶ Continuing development of streets and ganim.
- ▶ Updating signs for the streets and various Yishuv institutions.
- ▶ Upgrading the baseball field including construction of a running track.
- ▶ Assisting in building classrooms for Yeshivat Ner Tamid and acquiring the crucial Tofes 4 (permit).
- ▶ Upgrading the steps to the basketball court.
- ▶ Connecting the regional sewage system in progress.
- ▶ Upgrading playgrounds, enlarging the basketball court and adding exercise equipment next to the Moadon Noar.

Administration:

- ▶ Secured recent agreement with the Municipality (moetzah) to allocate additional resources toward garbage collection and disposal.
 - ▶ Installing mail boxes and separating mail from Ramat and Ganei Modiin in progress.
 - ▶ Provided staffing for additional hours for the distribution of mail in the evening and on Fridays.
- ▶ Publication of the minutes of the Board meetings on the Yishuv website.
