As a member of the council I served as the chairman of the finance committee, the chairman of tourism committee and a member of yishuvim committee.

I had three goals I aimed to achieve:

1. The construction of a kikar in the entrance to the yishuv on 446, as well as an exit from the yishuv to 446.
2. Building a sports hall
3. Helping individual residents with various issues dealing with the council.

BH all three goals were achieved together with the local vaad and the council.

In the upcoming term our goals:

1. Increasing the budget the yishuv gets from the council, in the west region of Binyamin and particularly in Hashmonaim.
2. Establishing an administration of west Binyamin- ensuring council services will be available in our area. All services, not a partial solution.
3. Providing comprehensive services to the senior citizens on the yishuv. There are many services these citizens are entitled to but don't receive. We plan to work together with the representatives of this group and the vaad.
4. Young families- in order to ensure the vitality and continuity of the yishuv we need to encourage young families to stay. These families need various services as well as additional building options. This is challenging because all the land surrounding the yishuv is private. We are trying to move things forward together with private investors and Regavim movement. The council will condition that building plans will be approved only if they include a certain percentage of the construction geared for young couples.
